<u>HKU Centre of Buddhist Studies</u> Language Courses Enrolment for MBS Graduates

Graduates of the Master of Buddhist Studies (MBS) programme have two options to take language courses:

* As Occasional Students (OS)

- > OS are entitled with the same assessment as ordinary students.
- A Certificate of Attendance with final grade will be issued to OS who have attended at least 80% of teaching sessions and completed all the required assignments/ examinations with a passing grade.
- The tuition fee is HK\$10,850 per course. For MBS graduates, the tuition fee can be waived for one course in each academic year.

- MBS graduates are welcome to sit in any MBS course for FREE. There is no limit on the number of sit-in courses.
- Sit-in students are not expected to join the course examinations or submit course assignments.
- > NO certificate will be issued.
