Criteria for the Award of Distinction

The award of a taught postgraduate qualification with an overall distinction is a recognition of excellence, a relatively rare achievement. To obtain an overall distinction, the candidate must

- (a) have received a CGPA of at least 3.8; and
- (b) have received a grade of A- (grade point 3.70) or above in the capstone experience;
and
- (c) have not received any grade below C+ (grade point 2.30) in all courses attempted.

All courses attempted, including failed courses, are counted towards the CGPA.
