<u>Master of Buddhist Studies 2025-2026</u> Important Notes on Course Selection & Programme Logistics

COURSE SELECTION

CURRICULUM STRUCTURE: All courses are offered on credit basis. Candidates must complete eight courses by selecting two compulsory foundation courses (9 credits each), five elective courses (6 credits each), and one course for capstone experience (12 credits). Candidates have to complete a total of 60 credits for graduation.

Compulsory Foundation Courses and Elective Courses

- 1. Please refer to the MBS Dates of Semesters 2025-26 for the course enrollment period, add/drop period, and assessment period. The finalized examination timetable will be available online in November 2025 and April 2026.
- 2. During the course enrollment period and add/drop period, students can attend ANY classes without registration. To finalize course selection, please complete online course selection by the deadline. Please enroll in courses for both the 1st and 2nd semesters (recommended).
- 3. Please log in <u>HKU Portal</u> to access the online course selection system. Please visit <u>here</u> for the user guide. New students must complete **Master Registration** before online course selection.

- 5. The capstone experience is <u>compulsory</u> and can be conducted in the following forms:
 - a. Submission of a dissertation (BSTC8999); or
 - b. Completion of an additional elective course (BSTC8xxx) together with the submission of a portfolio.
- 6. For submission of portfolio, the completion of an additional elective course should be done <u>in the final year</u>. Submission of portfolio and dissertation should also be done <u>in the final year</u> of study.

Capstone Experience

- 7. For full-time and final year students, please submit the "Capstone Experience Form for Submission of Proposal" to capstone@hku.hk by November 15, 2025. However, please note that completion of this form will NOT enable course enrollment for Capstone Experience.
- 8. Enrollment and add/drop of Capstone Experience must be done through HKU Portal during the course enrollment period or add-drop period.
